

This cotton canvas bucket can be used for bringing in the harvest from the garden, gathering weeds and debris, and for carrying water. Please note that before using to carry water, the bucket must be “seasoned” in order to make it watertight.

To “season” the canvas, fill the bucket with water. (We suggest you do this outdoors or in a basin or sink.) Let the water sit in the bucket for about 30 minutes, or until most of the water has seeped out. Top up with more water, and let it sit again. Repeat several times. You can expect a lot of water to seep through the bucket at first, but this will gradually diminish with each filling. As the fibers absorb the water, they will expand, making the canvas watertight.

To prevent damage to the canvas, avoid putting sharp objects into the bucket.

To prevent mildew during long periods of storage, allow the bucket to air dry completely. We do not recommend machine drying. Hand wash only.

If it has been a while since the bucket was used for holding water, it may be necessary to re-season it.
