

While this silicone piping bag can be used with or without a coupler, a coupler makes it quick and easy to change decorating tips without having to empty the contents of the bag.

Since couplers and decorating tips are available in a range of sizes, every new piping bag needs to be trimmed so that the selected coupler base fits into the narrow end of the bag.


Note: You may not need to trim the narrow end of the bag for the smaller couplers, so be sure to test the fit of the coupler base in the bag before using.

Preparing the silicone bag for use with a coupler


1. Remove the coupler ring from the coupler base.

2. Place the coupler base, narrow end first, into the bag and push it down as far as it will go.

3. With a pen, mark all the way around the outside of the bag, slightly above the bottom of the screw threads on the coupler base.



4. Take the coupler out and cut the bag at the marked line.



Tip: To avoid wasting a bag by cutting too much off of the narrow end of the bag, cut slightly above your marked line, test the fit, and then trim as required.

5. Put the coupler back into the bag and push it down until one or two of the screw threads extend past the opening.

6. Insert the desired decorating tip into the coupler ring and screw the ring onto the coupler base.
