

How to Pack Up the Shelter

Note: Maintain a firm grip on the frame during this process to avoid having it spring open accidentally.

1. Remove the ground stakes.
2. Be sure the shelter is empty and zip the flap closed.
3. To flatten the shelter, push one corner in toward the diagonally opposite corner, then fold the two sides together (ensuring zipper side faces in). (**Figure 1.**)
4. Hold the flattened shelter upright and fold it in half, top corner toward the diagonally opposite bottom corner (**Figure 2**).
5. Grab those corners with one hand, positioning the folded ends to one side.
6. Push the flexible poles down with the other hand, twisting the side of the net toward the center until the upper frame starts to loop into two circles (**Figure 3**). When twisting the sides, **do not** force them closed.
7. Gently coax the loops to fold into each other (**Figure 4**).
8. Snug up any loose edges, and slide the triple coiled shelter into the storage bag (**Figure 5**).

 **Caution:** Make sure the pop-up shelter is completely dry before storing it in the bag.
