- 1. Extend the parts (stopping just before their locking point), and then pull sharply to separate the slide members.
- 2. Determine and mark where the center line of the slide will land on the drawer bottom and the face frame rail at the front of the cabinet.
- 3. Measure the distance between the cabinet side and the center line mark on the frame rail. Transfer this measurement and mark a vertical center line onto the back of the cabinet. Use a square to ensure the back of the slide is at 90° in relation to the front of the cabinet.







4. Install the back-mount bracket onto the back of the cabinet slide member.

Note: The bracket permits up to a 13/4" adjustment for cabinet depth.

- 5. Position the front of the cabinet slide member about 1/8" in from the edge of the cabinet rail and secure with a wood screw.
- Use a level to ensure the back of the cabinet slide is in line with the front of the slide. Fasten the back-mount bracket onto the back of the cabinet with a screw.
- Cut a notch in the drawer back as required. Insert a screw at the front of the drawer slide member on the drawer bottom. Fasten the back of the slide with a screw.
- 8. If desired, secure the included drawer attachment clip to the back of the drawer, then insert the clip into one of the holes in the drawer slide member. The clip allows the drawer to disconnect from the slide by unscrewing the single front fastener.
- 9. Tap the included nylon glides on top of the cabinet rail, one at each side (as shown in **Figure 2**).
- 10. Slide the drawer into the cabinet to reconnect the slide members.
